

Policies & Procedures

Alcohol

- Any alcoholic beverage is prohibited in any of the indoor or outdoor facilities during a Megacity sport event.
- Drinking of alcoholic beverages during a Megacity sport event is not allowed

Location

- Megacity reserves the right to determine which facility will be used. If for any reason there is a change in facility, Team Captains will be informed 12 hours before the game and Megacity Basketball website will be updated

Minimum Age Requirement

- All players must be a minimum of 19 years of age to participate in any Megacity league

Privacy

- Megacity is the sole owners of the information collected for any Megacity event. Megacity only has access to collect information that you voluntarily give us via email or other direct contact from you. We will not share your information with any third party outside of Megacity. All personal information will be kept confidential.
- With the exception; photos, videos or film likeness taken during a Megacity event will be used on our website to promote our business. Some examples are on Facebook, Twitter, any Social Media website, post cards, posters, brochures, etc...
- If for any reason a Megacity members does not want their picture or video online, they may make a request by emailing general@megacitybasketball.com

Registration Cancellation

- Team Captains are responsible to inform Megacity by email at general@megacitybasketball.com of a cancellation request two weeks before the first scheduled game. There will be an administrative fee of \$200 (free agents, a fee of \$50).

Schedule

- Game schedules will be posted two weeks before the first scheduled game
- Megacity is not responsible to reschedule any games that teams cannot attend



- Megacity will attempt to reschedule any games cancelled due to weather or any interruption in the facility that it was originally scheduled at

Violence Policy

Megacity Basketball Incorporate is committed to the prevention of workplace violence. We will take whatever steps are reasonable to protect our workers from workplace violence from all sources. To ensure the safety of our staff, members, volunteers, friends and visitors, Megacity Basketball has a **Zero Tolerance Policy** for any violence in the leagues.

Violence is defined as:

- The exercise of physical force by a person against a worker or player during a Megacity event that causes or could cause physical injury to another person (Examples; hitting, shoving, pushing, kicking, etc...)
- An attempt to exercise physical forced against a worker or player, in a Megacity event, that could cause physical injury to the worker or player (Examples; threatening behaviour, shaking fists, destroying property, throwing objects, verbal/written threats, etc...)
- A statement or behaviour that it is reasonable for a worker or player to interpret as a threat to exercise physical force against the worker or player, during a Megacity event, that could cause physical injury to the worker or player (Examples; verbal abuse, swearing, insults, condescending language, etc...)

Policy Guidelines

- Megacity will not tolerate any violent behaviour from its staff, members/players, volunteers, friends and/or visitors. If any persons are involved in any violent behaviour defined above, that person will be removed from the premises immediately and suspended for the rest of the season. A Megacity staff shall be informed and the incident shall be documented.
- If a person is involved in a second incident for any violent behaviour defined above, that person will be suspended from any future Megacity events permanently.
- Megacity managers reserves the right to suspend any player or players, visitors or friends they believe that may cause a threat to the safety of others during a Megacity event.
- Megacity encourages all members of Megacity, staff, members/players, volunteers, visitors and guests to report all incidents of violence. All incidents shall be investigated promptly, fairly and effectively.

Waivers



- Waivers will be emailed to Captains and will also be available online. To participate in any Megacity games, waiver forms must be signed by all Megacity members before the first scheduled game.
